Treasurers Report – **\$**16,000 current, but a lot to be paid out soon. Direct donations currently at 2700, significantly lower than goal of \$35,000

Administration Report – Safety inspector recommends better communication to parents about protocol during things such as 'alert status' where nobody will be let in or out of the school. These apply even to drills. Drills are normally no longer than 5-10min, and most alert statuses have not lasted more than half an hour but should there be a longer event parents would be notified by a central authority such as ConnectEd through school communication channels.
